In 1982, when Manmin Church was founded, I saw my father completely healed through the prayer of Pastor Jaerock Lee. Currently my father, Pastor Youngsuk Kim, is serving the church as the General Guidance Teacher of Paul's Mission. While attending the worship service, I was so touched to see pianists and other players offering beautiful performances to God the Father, so I came to harbor a dream to become a pianist who glorifies God. At 9, I began learning to play the piano, but at 12 I had to give it up because of my family's financial situation. Five years later, when I was 17 years old, I was able to practice playing the piano again by the grace of God. One day one of my seniors at my high school recommended to me that I learn to play the organ. From that time I possessed a new dream of becoming an organist, and 2 years later in 1997, I entered the Seoul Theological University, the School of Church Music, and majored in the organ.

Began Having Organ Recitals by the Grace of God in the Midst of the Refinements of Faith

In 2001, I graduated and began playing the organ during the worship services of my church, Manmin Central Church. I continually felt I had to improve my skills because there was a limitation in my personal practice. I wanted to study and learn, but the actual situations did not allow me to do it. In September of 2007, my former professor at the university contacted me and I was given a good chance to learn the organ from him.

Three months later, in December of 2007, I held a pipe organ recital for the first time, and during the following 3 years I had organ recitals every year. In preparation for the concerts and recitals, thorough practice and unceasing training always followed prayer. As for me, I found myself practicing the organ as much as I saw fit and the same manner of life was found in my life of faith. My professor advised me saying, “While you are playing the organ, you are not listening to what the music is saying and instead you are trying to make the music follow your own thoughts.”

I repented and came to harbor even whatever little words he taught me, and to practice much more attentively. And I began trying my best to interpret exact meanings of each music piece and practiced organ performing techniques. Music scores then looked different to me and I felt my music abilities improving.

Sometimes I wanted to rest and give it up, but I endeavored renewing my heart by prayer and made all efforts until I had the assurance of my very best. I received Senior Pastor's prayer in season and reminded myself of the purpose of playing the organ. My offering the performances worthy of glorification of God required me to have as much prayer, love and patience. As the result of such patient trainings, I had recitals and I grew up in spirit.

My Faith Renewed, My Heart Filled with the Lord's Love

In August of 2010, in preparation for the trip to Europe for more study, God allowed for me to look back at my past life and thoroughly repent of my wrongdoings and errors. Among other things I repented with many tears and rending heart that I did not embrace my younger brother during our childhood; that I had not cultivated my heart by the Words of God I have heard for such a long time; that I had not prayed for my parents. I felt excruciatingly deep within my heart the love of my Savior Jesus who died on the cross for me—such a sinner that I couldn't see the cross without tears and I couldn't look at the Senior Pastor without shedding tears.

I felt so sorry before God that I had not served little children and not given heartfelt thanks to God while I felt under trials. The grace of God for my salvation was so great that I couldn't endure with anything else. Later I noticed all I can do to repay

His grace is cast away every form of evil, and since afterwards, I did my best to offer prayer and praise with my heart and fasted as many times as possible whenever my sins and sin natures were discovered. On July 17, I received Dr. Jaerock Lee's prayer for my trip to Europe and then prepared everything for it successfully.

Desiring to Renew As Many Souls through the Performance

The 13-day music journey in the four European countries—Austria, Italy, Slovenia and Germany I had from August 5 through 17 was a good chance for me to play the pipe-organ in Europe, the hometown of music and study the footprints of many historically famous musicians. Looking at the clear and blue sky, white and fluffy clouds, beautiful lakes, trees and flowers, elegant and praiseworthy buildings and palaces, great artworks, and magnificent pipe organs in cathedrals, my hope for the City of New Jerusalem became strong and determined to surely enter New Jerusalem.

The most memorable thing to me during the 13-day journey and study was the night sky I saw from the window of an upper room of the tallest house in Austria. The beautiful scenery of the sky and the Alps was gorgeously displayed. A great multitude of shining stars in various sizes and colors seemed to be falling down upon me. I felt I was alone in the vast universe and the sublimity and magnificence of it was beyond description. I was amazed at the wonder of the universe, and I sang the song “How Great Thou Art” without knowing. I looked at that night sky for more than an hour to put the beauty and God's love in my heart, and it was very fortunate that I saw stars move and shooting stars.

When I played the organ at the Maribor Cathedral in Slovenia, the cathedral's organist and church workers came to me and said it was such a wonderful performance, and asked me to visit there and play the organ once again. They testified that when they heard my performance with prayerful heart, their burdens and problems in heart had been resolved. I was encouraged at their words and experienced God's work that heals the souls of their broken heart through the fragrance of performance and music that are pleasing to God.

After completing the 13-day study journey on the way back home on the plane, I saw a clear circular rainbow surrounding the shadow of the plane and rejoiced with indescribable joy. I can never explain the touching emotion of the promise of the Lord's being with me through the rainbow.

I am still a person with deficiency and not an excellent player. But I am increasingly realizing the love of God the Father, the Lord Jesus Christ and Senior Pastor and believe the way to pay back for the love is to try my best up to the point of sanctifying my heart with the truth and offering God-pleasing performance and music to God. I hope to share this great love given freely with as many souls as I will be able. I give all thanks and glory to God and the Lord Jesus Christ and I send my heartfelt thanks to Senior Pastor Dr. Jaerock Lee.

The 28th Church Anniversary Celebration October 10, 2010

The Effective Prayer of a Righteous Man Can Accomplish Much

"And the prayer offered in faith will restore the one who is sick, and the Lord will raise him up, and if he has committed sins, they will be forgiven him. Therefore, confess your sins to one another, and pray for one another so that you may be healed. The effective prayer of a righteous man can accomplish much." (James 5:15-16)

What is the reason why some believers in God diligently pray, but fail to receive answers from God? God's answers depend on the measure of our love and faith and also of the righteousness we have accomplished in the sight of God. Anyone who is worthy to be called a righteous man by God and earnestly prays to God can receive answers quickly and glorify God.

1. God Answers Us When We Pray with Faith and Love

He who has spiritual faith believes in the power of the living God and believes in the Word of God recorded in the Bible even if it doesn't seem to agree with his thoughts and knowledge (Hebrews 11:1). And he believes in the works of God creating something out of nothingness. As a result, change in life and blessing come upon him and he comes to experience the power of God in whom nothing is impossible (Mark 9:23, 11:24).

In order to possess such spiritual faith and experience God's great power, we should not insist on our knowledge, but instead demolish all frames of knowledge and theories that are against the Word of God and continually follow the truth (2 Corinthians 10:5). To the extent that we destroy fleshly thoughts that are hostile against God and cast away untruths, our soul prospers and we can possess spiritual faith.

As we possess perfect and spiritual faith, we can heal the sick (James 5:15) and manifest miraculous signs that are not possible with men (Mark 16:17). And when we completely believe in God and boldly pray to Him without any doubt, we can experience God's works (James 1:6-7). A Roman centurion whose servant had been tormented by paralysis believed the servant would be able to be healed just by the word spoken by Jesus, and then he experienced Jesus' healing power by which the servant was immediately healed when Jesus commanded (Matthew 8:5-13).

In addition, when we pray with love, it accomplishes much more. If we confess our sins to one another, and pray for one another with love, even if some of us have committed sins, God will forgive them of their sins and heal them of their diseases through the prayer offered in faith and love. Thus, the prayer offered

in spiritual faith and spiritual love can call down God's great works.

2. The Prayer of a Righteous Man Accomplishes Much

Since the first man, Adam, sinned all men have sinned and fall short of glory of God (Romans 3:23). Now how can we become righteous? The God of love prepared the way of the cross in which we are forgiven of our sins and declared righteous through faith in Jesus Christ.

As recorded in Romans 3:24, "Being justified as a gift by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus," anyone who accepts Jesus Christ as the Savior receives the Holy Spirit as a gift of God and gains the right to become a child of God. Once anyone has been declared righteous by the grace of God, he must be set free from sin and become a servant to God to bear the fruit of holiness.

When we cast off untruths that are against God's Word and act by the truth, we can become a truly righteous man in the sight of God. When we have served as a righteous man and try our best to practice the Word of God, we can receive God's answers to our prayers. When we please God with faith and lead the life of a righteous man in which there is nothing to be condemned, God answers whatever we ask for (1 John 3:21-22).

Luke 18:1-8 describes the parable of an unrighteous judge who neither feared God nor respected men. Even though he was unrighteous, a widow kept coming to him and petitioning him, and finally he did her a favor. How much more willingly would a love-abounding God

answer the prayer of His children that they offer day and night? God will not delay long over them but bring about justice for them quickly.

In order to receive whatever we ask, we have to become a truly righteous man who is recognized by God. When we offer God fragrant prayers by acting by the Word of God and accomplishing goodness and beauty of heart like that of the Lord, we can receive His answers quickly.

3. The Gift of the Holy Spirit and the Power of God

If our soul has prospered and we have become a vessel proper for the use of God, we come to follow the will of the Holy Spirit and receive His gifts (1 Corinthians 12:1-11). The gifts of the Holy Spirit are given freely by God's grace for His special purpose.

When we become a truly righteous man and possess perfect faith and love, God gives us greater gifts and higher level of power so that we can reveal His glory. Elijah had the same nature that we have. He earnestly prayed to God when there had been no rain in Israel for 3 and a half years. When he prayed again, Heaven gave rain and the earth produced its fruit (James 5:17-18). By his prayer a dead child was brought back to life and fire came down from Heaven.

Biblical figures of faith were differently used for the kingdom of God. Some performed God's powerful works, some others manifested miracles, and still others carried out only a prophetic and teaching ministry without manifestation of miracles. God allows gifts of healing and power to those who are proper in the sight of God so that they may lead many more souls to the path to salvation. Thus, such people have to manifest such miracles and healing works by the guidance of the Holy Spirit and to do so they have to become righteous before God.

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, I pray in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ you may become righteous in the sight of God by obeying with faith and sacrificing with love and giving the glory to God in full measure through effective prayer of a righteous man that is worthy of accomplishing much.

Surveying the Footsteps of the Savior Jesus

The Providence of Salvation Is Embedded in the City of Jerusalem

The city of Jerusalem has more than 5,000 years of inhabited history. During its long history, Jerusalem has been destroyed twice, besieged 23 times, attacked 52 times, and captured and recaptured 44 times. Laying the city of Jerusalem in independent control of the Jebusites, King David of Israel first established Jerusalem as the capital of the United Kingdom of Israel in 1000 BC. His son, Solomon commissioned the building of the First Temple in the city. For more than 400 years, until the Babylonian conquest in 587 BC, Jerusalem was the political and religious capital of the United Kingdom of Israel and then the Kingdom of Judah. The First Temple period ended around 586 BC, as the Babylonians conquered Judah and Jerusalem, and laid waste to Solomon's Temple. The Temple and the city walls were almost destroyed and the Jews were taken away into slavery in Babylon. In 538 BC, after 50 years of Babylonian captivity, Persian King Cyrus the Great invited the Jews to return to Judah to rebuild the Temple. Construction of the Second Temple was completed in 516 BC, during the reign of Darius the Great, 70 years after the destruction of the First Temple.

The city of Jerusalem symbolizes the place of the choosing, presence, protection and glory of God, and at the same time, the place of judgment due to the disobedience of Israel. The second half of the public ministry of Jesus was accomplished here in Jerusalem, and it is characterized with Jesus' crucifixion for God's providence of salvation, resurrection, ascension into Heaven, and the Descent of the Holy Spirit, and the multiplication of the early churches. Despite all these facts, the Jews are still awaiting their Messiah without accepting Jesus as their Savior and many Orthodox Jews are living in the city of Jerusalem centering Judaism in Jerusalem.

The Garden of Gethsemane and the Church of All Nations

Gethsemane is a garden at the western foot of the Mount of Olives in Jerusalem. It overlooks the Kidron Valley, well known as the place where Jesus and His disciples regularly visited. Jesus was the Son of God. He came to the earth in a human form. He prayed with His disciples in this place the night before His crucifixion. Gethsemane is also a place that allowed for Judas to be able to find Jesus on the night of His arrest. The Church of All Nations was established in commemoration of the fact that Jesus prayed for the salvation of the souls at the Garden of Gethsemane, by the sponsorship of 16 nations including Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Mexico, Italy, France, Spain, UK, Belgium, Canada, Germany, USA, Ireland, Hungary, Poland and Australia.

Via Dolorosa, the Way of Suffering

Via Dolorosa is Latin words for the 'Way of Grief' or 'Way of Suffering' and is a street, in two parts, within the Old City of Jerusalem, held to be the path that Jesus walked carrying His cross on the way to His crucifixion. The current route was established in the 18th century, replacing various earlier versions and today it is 800 meters. The route is a place of Christian pilgrimage.

The Third Station of the Cross the place where Jesus fell the first time while carrying the heavy cross
The Twelfth Station of the Cross the place where Jesus died on the cross
The Fourteenth Station of the Cross the place where Jesus was laid in the tomb prepared by Joseph Arimathea

The Western Wall and an Islamic Mosque Set up at the Former Site of the Temple of God

The Western Wall (Hebrew: הַיְדִיבֵּה לְיְהוּדָה is also called 'Wailing Wall' or 'Kotel'). It is located in the Old City of Jerusalem at the foot of the western side of the Temple Mount. It is a remnant of the ancient wall that surrounded the Jewish Temple that was completely destroyed by the Roman soldiers in 70 AD. It is one of the most sacred sites in Judaism. The Western Wall had been a symbol of the dream of the Jews, who had been scattered all over the globe for 2,000 years. It is still a symbol of their dream of the Temple of God. While suffering from all afflictions and persecutions as a people who had no nation, they petitioned to God concerning their sufferings and pains. They have mourned here with many tears. That's why it was named the 'Wailing Wall.' At the site of the Temple of God is an Islamic mosque. During the destruction of Israel, Gentiles conquered the land of Israel and made it their holy land. Jerusalem is always at stake in the midst of unceasing disputes between Israel and Arab countries.

Dr. Jaerock Lee's Israeli Ministry for the Return of the Gospel into the Land of Israel

Since the founding of Manmin Central Church, Dr. Jaerock Lee prayed to awaken Israel, and from July of 2007 until September of 2009, he flew to Israel 12 times and traveled throughout all of Israel.
