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Power of God Awoke People in Europe Rev. Heesun Lee's Handkerchief Healing Meetings in Europe



Countless people have been healed of their diseases and found solutions to their problems through the handkerchiefs on which Senior Pastor Dr. Jaerock Lee prayed (Acts 19:11-12): Photo 1, Rev. God performed extraordinary miracles by the hands of Apostle Paul as recorded in Acts 19:11-12. When handkerchiefs or aprons were carried from his body to the sick, the diseases left them and evil spirits went out. Today God is still performing such extraordinary miracles through Senior Pastor Dr. Jaerock Lee. Through handkerchiefs on which he prayed, a great number of miraculous works have occurred all around the world. From June 9 through 24 in 2016, handkerchief healing meetings in Spain, France, Belgium, and Switzerland were led by Rev. Heesun Lee, Manmin World Guidance Pastor.

The first meeting was held in Samaria Church in Spain on June 12. Pastor José García, presiding pastor of the church, received grace from Dr. Jaerock Lee's sermons on Enlace TV and Manmin Central Church's website and asked for the handkerchief meeting in his church.

Rev. Heesun Lee delivered the message "Spiritual Faith and Fleshly Faith" taken from Hebrews 11:1-3. And she prayed for the sick with the handkerchief of power. Through the prayer, Mrs. María Martínez, who is Pastor José García's wife, was healed of

arthritis in her knees, and Brother Prece threw away his cane and came to walk for himself. Brother Jose Campos was healed of a slipped disk, Sister Ramia Yaich of asthma, and Sister Isabel of pelvic arthritis. Additionally, kidney disease, Crohn's disease, and many other diseases were cured.

On June 15, Rev. Lee appeared on a live program on HolyGod TV, France (President Pastor Uthayakumar Gerard). After Power Team's performance, she preached the message entitled "The Treasure of Treasures Is Faith" based on Hebrews 11:1.

In the evening of the day, she led another handkerchief healing meeting in Ile-de-France Manmin Church. There was a boy there who had been bent forward 90 degrees, but after he received the handkerchief prayer his body was straightened up (Refer to page 4).

On June 19, Hainaut Manmin Church in Belgium had its 3rd Anniversary Service. Rev. Lee preached the message and led the handkerchief healing meeting. After she prayed with the handkerchief, Brother Melvine and Sister Hoctence recovered eyesight of their left eye that had gone blind. Many people

were healed of many diseases including hearing impairment, asthma, herniated lumbar disk, arthritis, and depression.

On June 21, Rev. Lee led the handkerchief healing meeting in Switzerland Home Church. A man from Germany gained better eyesight in his both eyes so he threw away his eye glasses with thick lenses. Brother Chris,

a former soccer player, was healed of severe back pain.

The God of love showed the power of the Holy Spirit to the people in Europe. The show of His power showered them in His sweet rain of grace. Let's give all thanks and glory to God who poured the Holy Spirit upon people in Europe who had become stuck in spiritual stagnation.

The Shedding of Jesus’ Blood and Water

sinner. He was blameless, spotless, and righteous and God made certain that Jesus’ legs were not broken.

During the time of the Exodus, God told the Israelites in Numbers 9:12 and Exodus 12:46, “They shall eat lamb but not break any bone of it.” Throughout the Bible, “the lamb” symbolizes Jesus (John 1:29). Therefore, God commanded against the breaking the bone of a lamb, which signifies Jesus Himself, and precisely according to this word of prophecy, Jesus’ bones remained unbroken.

2. The Providence in Jesus’ Shedding His Blood and Water

As we read in John 19:34, “But one of the soldiers pierced His side with a spear, and immediately there came out blood and water,” a Roman soldier pierced the side of Jesus who had already passed away.

Jesus hanging on a cross with a crown of thorns, His body shredded from flogging, and blood streaming from His hands and feet where the nails pierced His body was a gruesome sight. From this scene, we know just how evil man really is as the Roman soldier, who confirmed that Jesus had breathed His last, nevertheless pierced His side with a spear.

What is the spiritual significance behind Jesus’ side being pierced by a spear and His shedding of blood and water?

1) It testifies that Jesus came to the world in the flesh of man.

John 1:14 tells us exactly who Jesus is. “And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us...” In other words, Jesus, begotten of God who is spirit, donned flesh and came into this world. Jesus was not conceived through the combination of a man’s sperm and a woman’s egg, but by the Holy Spirit. Yet, because He was born in flesh and underwent a normal growth process just like any other human being, Jesus satisfies the qualifications to be the Savior of all mankind. According to the four qualifications to be satisfied in order to become the Savior of mankind, the Savior must first be a man, yet not be a descendant of

Adam who had committed the sin of disobedience. He had to possess the power to overcome the enemy devil and He had to have love by which He could sacrifice His own life for others.

Therefore, Jesus came into this world with a body of bones and flesh, just like ours. He felt pain when He was flogged. He suffered from exhaustion, thirst, and hunger (Matthew 4:2; John 4:6). In order to validate the fact that Jesus came into this world in flesh, in the Bible it is recorded: “one of the soldiers pierced His side with a spear, and immediately there came out blood and water.”

2) It attests that a man with flesh can partake in the divine nature.

In Matthew 5:48, Jesus tells us, “Therefore you are to be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect,” God Himself reminds us again in 1 Peter 1:16, “You shall be holy, for I am holy.” Furthermore, in Philippians 2:5 we are urged to “Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus,” while 2 Peter 1:4 tells us, “For by these He has granted to us His precious and magnificent promises, so that by them you may become partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world by lust.”

While Jesus donned flesh like other men and women, He committed no sin and lived a sanctified life. He experienced a variety of emotions for He also had the nature of man, yet Jesus lived only by the truth. By the same token, like our Jesus, we can also become sanctified and perfect, and partake in the divine nature with the heart of Jesus Christ.

Anyone who believes in the Lord, prays fervently, and makes every effort can rid himself of all sin and evil. In doing so such a person will surely receive and experience God’s grace and strength as well as the help of the Holy Spirit. None of us will be able to give the excuse, “Jesus could live a sanctified life because He was the Son of God, but since I am a mere man, I could not do that.”

3) It proves that by Jesus’ blood and water, we gain true life and enjoy


eternal life.

Truly precious is the blood of Jesus, who had no original sin within Him and who committed no personal sins. By this precious blood of our Jesus, we can, by faith, receive forgiveness of our sins and live forever. Moreover, water spiritually symbolizes “the Word”; as much as we hear God’s Word and live by it, we can rid ourselves of sin and evil and become much more righteous.

The blood and water Jesus shed are the blood and water of strength by which we can be transformed, and are the blood and water of life that deliver us from death. The fact that Jesus was pierced through His side with a spear and shed all His blood and water testifies to how we have received forgiveness because of Jesus. And we have received the strength by which we can live by God’s Word and gained true life.

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, Jesus rejoiced and gave thanks in the midst of His suffering because He thought of how countless souls would receive salvation through His suffering. Keep in mind that Jesus suffered and shed all His water and blood in order to save us.

I pray in the name of the Lord that you will quickly fathom this love of the Lord and keep it deep in your heart. Rid yourself of sin and evil and recover the image of God so you can enjoy eternal joy and blessing in the glorious heavenly kingdom.

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Endless Love of Mercy and Forgiveness

The God of love opened the way to salvation by giving His only begotten Son Jesus as an atoning sacrifice. Until many people become His true children, He waits with patience and shows His endless love of mercy and forgiveness. He guides them to New Jerusalem. Let's now look into the depth of His love through biblical examples and offer our thankful hearts to the God of love all the time.

God Wants to Save People at Any Cost

In Matthew 18:21-22, Peter, one of Jesus' disciples, came and said to Jesus, "Lord, how often shall my brother sin against me and I forgive him? Up to seven times?" Then, Jesus said to him, "I do not say to you, up to seven times, but up to seventy times seven."

The 'seven' is the number of perfection, and seventy times is the tenfold of seven. Jesus said, 'up to seventy times seven'. It

means boundless forgiveness. That is, it is perfect forgiveness and love. Some people mistakenly think God judges people strictly and solely according to justice and the law because they do not know about Him. However, when you look closely into the Bible, you will find many examples that show the deep and great love of God who wants to save no matter what it takes. Is there the end to God's mercy and forgiveness?

Jeremiah 18:7-8

"At one moment I might speak concerning a nation or concerning a kingdom to uproot, to pull down, or to destroy it; if that nation against which I have spoken turns from its evil, I will relent concerning the calamity I planned to bring on it."

God told Jonah to go to Nineveh the capital city of Assyria, which was a hostile nation towards Israel, and to cry out against it because their wickedness came up before Him. Jonah cried out and told the people of Nineveh that it would be overthrown in forty days. Surprisingly, all people of Nineveh including even the king and his nobles called for a period of fasting, put on sackcloth, and repented. They even didn't let their flocks and herds eat. When God saw their deeds, He relented concerning the calamity and did not do it (Jonah 3).

Ezekiel 33:14-16

"But when I say to the wicked, 'You will surely die,' and he turns from his sin and practices justice and righteousness, if a wicked man restores a pledge, pays back what he has taken by robbery, walks by the statutes which ensure life without committing iniquity, he shall surely live; he shall not die. None of his sins that he has committed will be remembered against him. He has practiced justice and righteousness; he shall surely live."

God does not punish wicked men immediately after they committed sin. But He wants to save them in any way He can. He gives them the opportunity to repent with love towards them. If they repent from their hearts and turn from their sins, He forgives them as if He has

waited for the moment and He will not remember their iniquity.

When King Hezekiah became mortally ill, he thoroughly repented before God. Then, 15 years was added to his life (2 Kings 20:1-7). King Manasseh worshiped idols and did evil in the sight of God. Eventually he was captured and taken to Babylon. But when he humbled himself greatly before God and prayed, God brought him again to his kingdom (2 Chronicles 33:10-13).

Luke 15:31-32

"And he said to him, 'Son, you have always been with me, and all that is mine is yours. But we had to celebrate and rejoice, for this brother of yours was dead and has begun to live, and was lost and has been found.'"

This was the word of a man to his older son. He had two sons. The younger of them asked his father to give him the share of the estate that was to fall to him. He received it, went on a journey, and squandered his estate with loose living. When he came back home with nothing, the father welcomed him and threw a party. Seeing it, the older son felt bad and complained and the father spoke to him as he did.

If the older son had understood his father's love and had mercy and love for his brother, he would not have complained. He would have felt thankful to his father for forgiving him. He would also have run and hugged his brother, asking how he had been.

The father thought about his younger son all the time and waited for him. When the son came back in shabby appearance, the father felt compassion and held the party. This kind of love is the Father God's endless love of mercy and forgiveness.

Jesus' Intercession for Souls

As the first Son of God, Jesus showed the love like that of the father who welcomed his prodigal son. He comforted the heart of the Father with words of goodness by talking about His brother's good points. And He looked for his brother here and there and found out he was taken as a slave. He found that He should pay a tremendous amount for him. By paying the price to his brother's master, He opened the way for his brother to return to the Father. Moreover, He is even now interceding for the brother before the Father so that he can be forgiven.

During His public ministry on the earth, Jesus prayed habitually to God. He gave thanks to Him for being able to sacrifice Himself for us and prayed to God for us. Even when He was crucified, He prayed even for those who persecuted and ridiculed Him and nailed Him on the cross (Luke 23:34).

His intercession is still going on unceasingly without skipping a day, a minute, or a second.

Even after His resurrection and ascension to heaven, He refused to sit on the throne in Heaven full of the glorious light on the right hand of God's throne. Even without eating anything, He has been praying for us all the time.

With the desire for all people to be saved and enter Heaven, He has been praying. And He will be praying until the human cultivation ends and the saved people enter the glory of Heaven.

Therefore, saved people should remember that they are living upon the prayer of the Lord filled with love. Then, they should also forgive their brothers and add love to the forgiveness (Matthew 5:23-24; Colossians 3:13-14).

I had dyspraxia since I was very little. Worse, I started to suffer from anxiety disorder two years ago. The dyspraxia caused my body to be completely bent such that my head touched my knees while I was walking. After many medical tests, the doctors diagnosed me with Asperger syndrome. I had counseling with many psychiatrists, psychologists, and psychotherapists and received medical treatments as an in-patient in hospitals. But my symptoms did not improve at all. Beginning two years ago, I started to take many kinds of medicine.



In the meantime, my classmate's mother Mrs. Lilou told my mother that a Korean pastor would come to Ile-de-France Manmin Church from South Korea. She said the pastor would pray for the sick after delivering the message. She asked my mother to come together, and it gave me hope.

On June 15, 2016, I went to Ile-de-France Manmin Church with my parents. Rev. Heesun Lee prayed for me several times with the handkerchief on my head and back (Acts 19:11-12). As I received the prayer, my body straightened up and I finally came to stand upright!

I was filled with joy and happiness. Rev. Lee had me surrounded by the church members and they prayed together for me. They also praised together with me. Some of them shed tears.

Eventually my body was completely straightened up. Rev. Lee asked me if I believed in God and if I believed He had healed me. I said "Amen". At first, I spoke with a little lower voice but kept saying "Amen," and my voice became louder and louder. The church members looked so happy and I was also overwhelmed by the love of God. When I went out of the church, I walked the way normal people walk and got into the car. My body remained straight on the way back home. I felt happy and free.

The next day, I left for a vacation with my mother and visited my grandmother in Normandy. As I was normal, I acted confidently and offered my grateful heart to God who healed me during the whole journey.

I still give thanks to God who saved me when I go to bed, when I wake up, and when I do something during the day. I can now go shopping, eat in restaurants, and go for a walk. I give all thanks and glory to Jesus Christ, my Lord who healed me!

We Saved the Driver from the Bus That Was on Fire Caused by Collision

On May 31, 2016, it was around 6 P.M. We were on the way to Daegu for a business trip. By the time we had almost reached Sangju City in Kyeongbuk Province through Jungbu Naeryuk Expressway, we saw dark smoke in the distance, maybe around 500m. An express bus's rear part was on fire since it had collided with a big trailer.

We stopped our car and tried to put out fire with the fire extinguisher in the trunk, but it was out of control. The fire made dark and thick smoke. We stopped the cars coming up from behind to prevent more accidents. The bus driver was unable to get out of it because the front part of the bus was so dented backward and his legs were stuck in the crushed parts.

A wrecker vehicle came upon the report of accident. We tied a metal chain to the bus' steering wheel and pulled it from outside to make space for the driver. Right then, we felt that we could no longer spend time there. And we ran into the bus.

The driver was almost unconscious covered with blood. And a young woman was administering first aid to him. We took his both legs slowly and carefully from the dented parts and tried to move him out of the bus together.

The fire looked unusual. Some police officers arrived. Helping them we made the bus passengers and the towing vehicle parked next to the bus move farther away from the bus. The fire became more serious and was spread to the whole thing. The windows were broken and the shards of glass were flying towards the cars in the opposite direction. We stopped those cars too. A few minutes later the bus was burnt to ashes in the great fire. This accident caused the cars in both directions to stop for around an hour.

Then, 119 rescue cars arrived. After we saw the injured and the passengers get in the cars, we left for Daegu again. When we saw the fire coming up from the bus, we both wanted to stop and help. It was because we have learned goodness and duty of man from Senior Pastor Dr. Jaerock Lee. We realized it again and felt so thankful.

We thought only about saving the driver when we ran into the car on fire. It was possible because we had seen our shepherd sacrifice himself without sparing anything for the kingdom of God and his flock. And it was because we had heard so many testimonies in which Manmin members were protected even in many kinds of accidents. What was really amazing was we did not smell nor feel any toxic gasses although the bus was on fire. We did not suffer from any aftereffects.

We thought about the good Samaritan. He could not pass by a man who fell into the robbers' hands and helped him. We give thanks to Senior Pastor who has taught us to practice goodness like the Samaritan through the teaching of the word of life (Luke 10:30-37). I give all thanks and glory to God who blesses us to experience the power of God in this church and live with no worries and with hope for Heaven.
