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## “We Are Delivering the Lord’s Love!” The 20<sup>th</sup> Love-Kimchi Sharing Event



Manmin Central Church has practiced the Lord’s love and service with charitable works as the all-time prayer title just as the Lord commands in John 13:34, “...even as I have loved you, that you also love one another.”

The church has given living expenses, rice, and side dish to 1,300 households in need every month. It has offered scholarships regularly to students who struggle to afford their tuition and has given rice to public offices and welfare centers. Additionally, the church members make kimchi and share it with neighbors in need every winter.

On November 22 and 23 2017, the Women’s Mission held the 20th Love-Kimchi Sharing Event. In fair weather, approximately 1,300 people including the mission members, Maintenance Bureau workers, and many full-time workers joined the work. They made kimchi with fervor and love for neighbors.

They salted the cabbages, made seasoning, and finished making kimchi. Ten to twelve kg of kimchi was put into each box, and the kimchi boxes were delivered to households that the church helps. To help neighbors in need they also sent the kimchi

to Sindaeabang 2-dong Community Service Center, Garibong-dong Community Service Center, Gurogu Vocational Rehabilitation Center for People with Special Needs, and Korea Rehabilitation Agency.

Senior Deaconess Maljin Kim donated cabbages that she had harvested and Deaconess Woongsun Kim provided the salt with thanks for God’s power, the Lord’s love and the shepherd’s prayer.

Let’s give all thanks and glory to the God of love who allowed us to celebrate the Lord’s birth by holding this event in happiness and prosperity.

### “I give thanks for healing my grandson of a serious burn to his face!”



It was on January 28, 2006, the day before the Lunar New Year’s holiday. My daughter-in-law was preparing food for the holiday, and her eight-month-old son was playing in a baby walker. When she went to the restroom, the baby’s walker-wheels tipped over on the threshold and he fell head-long into a large fry pan full of boiling oil and burned the left side of his face very seriously.

My son grabbed him and lifted him up quickly. But, my grandson slipped from his hands because he was covered with so much oil. Again, he fell into the pan of oil. I got to him and hurriedly sprayed Muan Sweet Water on his face. It is the water that was the salty water that came from a well but was changed into drinkable fresh sweet

water by Dr. Jaerock Lee’s prayer (Exodus 15:25).

I also let him hear Dr. Lee’s prayer for the sick recorded on the automatic response system. During the prayer, my grandson who was screaming in tears stopped crying. Fortunately, it was Lunar New Year’s holiday when Senior Pastor had time with the church members in his residence. So, my son, daughter-in-law, and I went to Seoul from Haenam in Jeonnam Province to meet Senior Pastor, and we received his prayer. Afterwards, my grandson was healed very quickly. He was in the danger of going blind in his left eye but the swelling on the eye subsided. Blisters and discharge on his face dried and scabs covered his face within six days. New flesh developed under the scabs. Around three weeks after the accident, the scabs all fell off and his face had become clean

with no scars remaining. Hallelujah!

He has been growing healthily in the Lord, and he is now a sixth grader. Whenever I see him, I am touched by the love of the shepherd who prayed to heal him without scaring. I give all thanks and glory to God of love.

“And without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is and that He is a rewarder of those who seek Him” (Hebrews 11:6).

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If you believe God will reward you, you will be able to cast away sins with hope for Heaven and joy. You will also be able to seek the kingdom and righteousness of God, work faithfully with your life, and thereby receive the crown of righteousness and dwell in glory. What will happen when you believe God is a rewarder?

### 1. You can become a good-hearted worker who completely believes and obeys the Lord.

Jesus said in John 12:44-45, “He who believes in Me, does not believe in Me but in Him who sent Me. He who sees Me sees the One who sent Me.” God sent Jesus, and Jesus did everything according to God’s will. Thus, believing in Jesus is the same with believing in God.

It is through Moses that God led the Israelites, who had been taken captive in Egypt, to Canaan, the land flowing with milk and honey. Today, through the spiritual messages delivered by His servants, He has been leading believers to beautiful Heaven. If you understand this spiritual order, you will trust and obey the shepherd whom God set up just as sheep hear and follow their shepherd. Thereby, you will be able to bear abundant fruit and glorify God.

Timothy in the Early Church time is one of the examples. He helped the ministry of the apostle Paul, and took part in sufferings

Paul underwent for the gospel until the end. After the apostle Paul established a church and left for another ministry, Timothy took care of the church in accordance with Paul’s teaching and encouraged believers’ faith in the truth (Philippians 2:19-22).

Today as well, churches need trustworthy and good-hearted workers who look after believers’ circumstances with the heart of the shepherd and devote themselves to the work of God.

Some people say they believe in God, but they do not seek the kingdom of God first above all else. They put every effort and much time in achieving their personal goals, but they are not earnest in works related to the church. However, Timothy put his everything in the work for the Lord Jesus Christ and dedicated himself to the gospel until the end.

If you believe God as a rewarder, you will fulfill your God-given duties like Timothy did, no matter how insignificant they may appear to be. You will visit believers with love for the souls. You will help or pray for them with joy and thanks. God the Rewarder will let you reap thirty, sixty, even a hundred times more when His loving children sow with faith, hope, and love. You will reap not only heavenly rewards but also abundant fruit on the earth.

The apostle Paul regarded Timothy as his son because Timothy was with Paul as a child would always be with his father. It was so even when Paul toiled and received sufferings for the gospel. When Paul suffered from all kinds of persecutions such as being beaten and imprisoned, Timothy joined the suffering as well. When Paul was faced with difficulties, Timothy prayed together with him, and he prayed for the church and believers in lamentation and tears.

Therefore, if you long for heavenly rewards and want to receive praise by fulfilling your duties well and become the light and salt of the

world, then you should trust and obey the shepherd with good heart just as Timothy believed and obeyed the apostle Paul.

### 2. You can be led by the Holy Spirit through His voice and His urging.

When a ship sails, it is very important for the captain to clearly know the destination and route. Only then can the ship avoid rocks and dangerous places and reach the destination safely.

Church workers are spiritual leaders who lead other believers like the captain of a ship. Thus, they should always be aware of the will of God. Otherwise, they themselves will go the wrong way and even mislead many people. Worse, they will put others into death (Matthew 15:14).

Therefore, if you have a precious God-given duty, you should destroy fleshly thoughts and fight against sins to the point of shedding blood in order to hear the Holy Spirit’s voice and be guided by Him. You should see, hear, and think only in goodness. You should pray earnestly to receive the fullness of the Holy Spirit. Then the Spirit will move your heart and let you realize the will of God and guide you every step.

To hear the voice of the Holy Spirit clearly and to be urged by Him, you must become sanctified by means of God’s Word and prayer (1 Timothy 4:5). You should cast away every form of evil by praying fervently (1 Thessalonians 5:22).

After called by God as a servant of Christ, the apostle Paul went to Arabia and communicated with God first. And while doing his ministry, he planned to go to Asia and spread the gospel, but after he realized the Spirit’s will through a spiritual vision, he went to Macedonia and preached the gospel. When he obeyed the voice of the Spirit, the gate to the world mission was widely opened.

He was guided by the Holy Spirit even in the prison and delivered the will of God in letters. So, he could make churches firm on faith.

1 Corinthians 3:9 refers to those with God-given duties as God’s fellow workers. If you are God’s fellow worker, you should figure out every moment what God wants, and then you should obey it. You should commit everything to God by prayer and let the Holy Spirit guide you. Only then can you reap abundant fruit. If you do not, you cannot bear fruit even though you think you work hard and faithfully.

When you make a plan, you should discern the will of God. Suppose God wanted you to do something but you did another thing in accordance with your thoughts. Then, the Holy Spirit cannot work for you and you cannot bear fruit. You may say what you did is not against the truth. But only when you follow and obey what is pleasing to God can you experience the work that God guarantees.

Therefore, leaders in the Lord should believe God is a rewarder, pray all the time above all else, and hear the Spirit’s voice and be urged to be led by Him. When they do everything according to God’s heart and will, they can please God.

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, the apostle Paul gave up everything of the world to spread the gospel and consider what he had loved as rubbish. He learned how to get along with humble means; in any and every circumstance he learned the secret of being filled and going hungry, both of having abundance and suffering need. Even if he was being poured out as a drink offering upon the sacrifice and service of brothers’ faith, he joyfully gave up everything.

I pray in the name of the Lord that you will believe God the rewarder, work to the point of death, and enjoy everlasting rewards in beautiful Heaven.

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# Cultivate Perfect Goodness

God is good. He wants His loving children to achieve His goodness.  
 If you achieve goodness in your heart, you will be able to gain true peace in the Lord,  
 fulfill your duty well, and become a great person in Heaven.  
 Let's delve into three ways to cultivate perfect goodness in your heart.



**You should not feel uncomfortable to anybody.**

If you've cultivated perfect goodness, you won't feel any discomfort toward anyone (Luke 6:45).

Even if others' ideas are not in accordance with yours, or their words or behaviors are not in accordance with yours, you will not feel any discomfort. Rather you will pay attention to them with a broad heart. You will not pass a quick judgment nor spurn their suggestions. You will think and say in only goodness.

On the contrary, if you haven't

cultivated perfect goodness, you will still have your own thought and self-righteousness and self-framework. Then, you may feel uncomfortable when you meet with something that doesn't agree with your idea. If you have more evil, your discomfort may be revealed in words and deeds.

Some of you may say, "That person acts offensively towards me all the time. He always makes me uncomfortable." It shows you don't know you revealed evil with such words and uncomfortable feeling.

You may even pass judgment that he tried to make you uncomfortable on purpose. This kind of thinking is far from goodness.

You should check yourself. 'Did I understand him in goodness? Do I have discomfort to him? Do I try to stay far away from him? Do I judge him, make a rumor about him, and spread it?' You should check yourself according to the Word of God. You should thereby achieve the heart of goodness in which you have no discomfort to anyone.



**You should understand others and seek their benefit.**

If you seek others' benefits from your heart, it shows that you have spiritual love in your heart. You should seek others' benefits with spiritual love in the truth. To do so, you should pay attention to their hearts.

Some of you may give a hard time to others although you say you seek their benefits. That is, you force them to do something or give something because you think it is good although they do not want to do it.

If you care about others'

hearts and seek their benefits, they will find comfort in you. If you pile up such good deeds of seeking others' benefits, you will cultivate virtuous generosity in you and you will be able to give peace and joy to many people.

And you will be able to pursue peace with all men and love everyone. Then, you can maintain peace even with those who hate you. When they brought troubles to you, you will understand their hearts and treat them in goodness. Then, your goodness

will touch their hearts and you will be able to be at peace with them.

To understand others, you should understand their growth background. When you try to understand their hearts and treat them accordingly, you can keep peace with them.

Proverbs 16:7 says, "When a man's ways are pleasing to the LORD, He makes even his enemies to be at peace with him." As mentioned, you can receive God's answers and guarantees.



**You should serve others even by sacrificing yourself.**

Service is not only to humble yourself, but it is also to seek others' benefit and fill their needs. As salt loses its shape and melts to season the food, true service is to fill others' needs even by sacrificing yourself.

Service is also to serve each other in the Lord. You should serve one another according to the order. Matthew 23:11 reads, "But the greatest among you shall be your servant." You should try to serve others as you become a leader.

When you want to be served, you will have discomfort or break peace. Suppose someone feels uncomfortable in heart when

others offer such opinions that are different from his or do not follow his plans. He may feel uncomfortable and stay far away from them. He may even think that he will not work with them, and worse, he may exclude them from the work.

On the contrary, good-hearted people do not have discomfort towards those who have points of view different from their own. They will not insist that they are right, and will try to understand their counterparts' positions and heart. In addition, they will seek others' benefits, respect others' opinions, and think in goodness.

Even if they hear the voice

of the Holy Spirit better, they will not let others' words pass by. They will listen humbly to others' words if they are in the truth even if the speaker is a little child. They will even keep the words in mind and pray with the words.

They will rejoice even if someone who is less deserving than them receives praise from others. They will rejoice more when others are better off than when they are. They will rejoice and give thanks from the heart.

Let's pursue only goodness, not evil, and receive blessings God prepares for us by longing for perfect goodness.



## “I was healed of acute myocarditis by the power of prayer!”

On August 11, 2017, I had a headache. It became worse and I got a fever as well. I vomited everything I had eaten. I had chest pain and difficulty in breathing. The symptoms lasted all night. I could not sleep nor eat. I could not even drink water.

On the 14th I went to the hospital to find the cause. After I had undergone several tests including an ECG, I was diagnosed with cardiac insufficiency. The doctor told me that the disease usually occurs to the elderly over fifty. He said he did not know why it happened to me. He told me to go to another bigger hospital for a more thorough check-up.

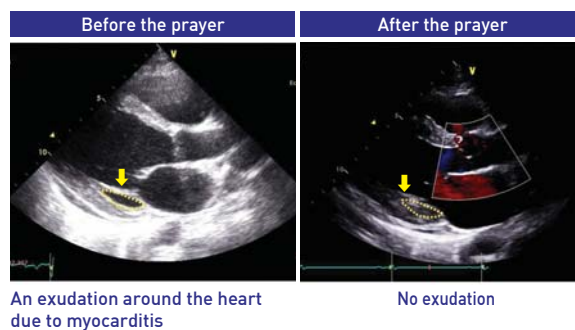
However, I returned home because I wanted to receive healing by faith. I began to repent that I had pursued worldly pleasure though I thought I kept my faith. I wrote a letter to Senior Pastor Dr. Jaerock Lee who was praying in his mountain prayer house and sent my prayer request to him.

On the 20th I heard that he prayed earnestly for me and I became convinced that I had been healed. The next day I went to a hospital that specialized in heart diseases with my X-ray, echocardiogram, and blood test results from the previous hospital and the doctor's note for more thorough tests.

The doctor there looked through it all. With a serious look he said my heart was ill-functioning

seriously. He suggested checking again. After thorough examinations of my heart, he said that my heart condition had improved a lot. My disease was cardiac insufficiency caused by acute myocarditis which is inflammation in the heart from high fever. He added that one in three that have the disease dies within one or two weeks, and the remaining two of three cannot live a normal life. He showed the data from the previous hospital and said that I had had fluid in many parts of the heart and the valves of the heart were opened widely and were 'dangling'. My heart function level was approximately 30% although normal people's level is over 55%. The test results showed I had been in a very serious state.

However, the test results I went through in the clinic showed that only a little bit of fluid was



left in a part of the heart, and though the valves were open quite a little bit the heart function level reached 54.2%! My heart was almost in a normal state. A month later I had a retest on September 28 and it proved that my heart was normal.

Since I was healed by Senior Pastor's powerful prayer, I have stayed healthy. Moreover, it was an opportunity to stop following any worldly pleasure no matter how small it seems, and realized that every single day is so precious to me.

I give all thanks and glory to God who healed me, and extend my heartfelt thanks to Senior Pastor who prayed for me with love.
