Manmin Praise Has Been Translated in 11 Languages and Distributed Worldwide

According to Deuteronomy 31, God let Moses write a song and teach it to the sons of Israel so that they would not forget the Law of God and the work of His love for them.

Today, evil and sin are prevalent all over the world, and Christians are in dire need of praises that are in accordance with God’s heart. Senior Pastor Dr. Jaerock Lee was fully aware of this necessity and he offered up earnest prayer. In response, the God of love Himself has been providing beautiful melodies and lyrics.

The first song, “The Lord’s Confession” was given on February 3, 2009, and now the number of God-given songs has reached 345. The songs are easy to learn regardless of gender and age, and even a short song expresses a variety of elements of music.

The songs have been translated in 11 languages including English and Chinese, and moreover, many overseas members have practiced the songs with Korean lyrics, saying that they receive much grace and emotion when they sing in Korean. The Manmin Praise serves as a cord that binds Manmin

members all around the world together more tightly.

Manmin Praise has delivered the love of God to the members, given hope for the beauty of heaven and purified their hearts. It’s because the work of the power of re-creation is manifested in the songs by bringing peace and emotion, driving away darkness, leading to the works of repentance, healing, answers, and blessing, and problem-solving.

Sincere Heart and Full Assurance of Faith

contents of untruths began to fill his heart. He became a man of flesh whose heart was a mixture of truth and untruth. He could no longer communicate with God like before. As time passed, the hearts of Adam’s descendants were increasingly stained by the untruths. They became more and more distanced from God and instead of communicating with God, they began to have communication with the enemy devil and Satan.

But thankfully, God who is full of love sacrificed Jesus His only begotten Son as propitiation to recover the relationship between the Father and His children. Also, He sent the Helper the Holy Spirit, so the people could call God “Abba Father” (Romans 8:15). He leads us to cultivate a sincere heart and to have the full assurance of faith so that we can share true love with God and live happy lives. For the life on this earth, He wants us to enjoy the authority of God’s children and lack nothing, like Adam once did. And later, He wants us to inherit the kingdom of heaven and come into the city of New Jerusalem where God’s throne is located.

2. Points to consider for the accomplishment of a sincere heart and full assurance of faith

1) The sons of Israel couldn’t cast away changing mind.

God showed compassion on the sons of Israel who were crying out when enslaved in Egypt. He sent Moses and Aaron to set them free from the Pharaoh and to lead them to the Canaan Land, a land flowing with milk and honey.

But as soon as they came out of Egypt, the people began to complain and kept on complaining. God parted the Red Sea and let them cross it like on dry land. He fed them with manna and quail. But soon after they saw the miracles their minds changed, and they complained. Because their minds were changing all the time, they couldn’t believe the promise of the faithful God.

Nevertheless, in consideration

of Moses, God was patient with them and guided them to the entrance of Canaan Land after the 40 years in the wilderness. Even at this moment, they were still complaining. Just before entering the land, many people had to face meaningless deaths due to their sin. They were bitten by fiery serpents in the wilderness.

Even though you have experienced countless signs, wonders, and powerful works, if you still have a changing mind, you cannot receive blessings. It is because it is like turning over your vessel when you complain or break peace according to your mood or situations due to your changing mind, which makes it impossible for the vessel to receive blessings. Only when you cast away this changing mind can you achieve a sincere heart and then be given the perfect faith to believe from the depth of your heart.

2) The Israelites looked at the world until the end.

As God chose the Israelites as God’s elect, He gave them commandments and constantly urged them to keep them. He didn’t just give them words, but He let them know that the wages of sin is death by making them give animal sacrifices for their sins. Also, they witnessed their own people and neighbors being killed in the wilderness as the punishment of their sins.

Nevertheless, some of the sons of Israel played harlot with the Moabite women just before they entered the Canaan Land. They also committed an act of rebellion in idolatry. So, more than 20,000 people died of a plague. Also, while conquering the Canaan Land, a person named Achan out of his greed stole a part of the spoils given to God, and he was stoned to death.

The Canaan Land that God gave to Israel was abundant land flowing with milk and honey. At the same time, it was full of sins of the people there so that they had to be judged. If they were careless for a moment, they could be complacent in the abundance or become stained

by pleasures of the world. For this reason, God trained the sons of Israel to make them His holy people through the long life in the wilderness.

Are you confident that even in those circumstances your heart would be set on God and keep His commands? Now, I ask you in the name of the Lord that you will cast away your love for the world completely and love God foremost of all, so that you’ll be able to achieve a sincere heart and have perfect faith.

3) The Israelites couldn’t gain complete victory due to their arrogance.

Caleb relied on God completely, and he took the land that God promised to give him. On the contrary, some tribes like Dan relied on their own methods and power, and they couldn’t completely take the portion that was given to them. Even Joshua, the successor of Moses, was prosperous when he asked God’s will, but when he didn’t ask God’s will, he was cheated by Canaanites (Joshua 9).

Arrogance is rooted very deep in one’s mind. Thus, you should humbly rely on God to cast it off and achieve a sincere heart. If you arm yourself with the word of God and prayer by relying on the power of God, you will discover evil conscience that is difficult to realize and even the evil placed deep in your nature, and pull them out, not to mention evident evil (Hebrews 10:22).

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, to cultivate a sincere heart and have the full assurance of faith, we must circumcise our heart. Just as we cut off the foreskin that would become dirty again soon, we should cut off the foreskin of the heart that can easily be defiled by sins and evil (Jeremiah 4:4). If we put the truth in our heart that has been circumcised, we will be able to have full assurance of faith and receive whatever we ask for. I pray in the name of the Lord that by doing so you will enjoy true happiness forever.

In today’s passage, the God of love urges us to have a sincere heart and full assurance of faith. It is because we will be able to receive His great love when we achieve it.

So, how should we pray and what should we pray for to achieve a sincere heart and full assurance of faith? Let’s think about it through the Israelites who couldn’t go into the Canaan Land even after the 40 years of life in the wilderness.

1. The reason we should long for a sincere heart and full assurance of faith

A sincere heart refers to a pure and truthful heart free of falsehood or change. Full assurance of faith is the spiritual faith given by God from above when we cultivate such a sincere heart. It is the faith to please God by obeying Him with an understanding of His heart and will. Namely, it is the true faith with which you don’t doubt God at all.

Adam, when he was a living spirit, didn’t need the word ‘sincere heart’. It’s because his heart itself was spirit. His heart was filled only with the contents of truth. So, he only obeyed God and was loved by God to the utmost degree. As the lord over all things created by God, Adam had great wealth and honor, but above all, he could communicate with God who is spirit.

But from the time he sinned,

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True Obedience

Jesus obeyed God to the point of dying on the cross for the providence of salvation.
 Jesus could do so because He loves Father God. Since He loves God, He lowered Himself,
 only obeyed, and accomplished the providence of the cross with joy.
 To achieve the providence for the end time as well,
 we should correctly understand the will of God and obey it.



First of all, we must not have our ego or 'self' but only God in us.

Those who love God should want to obey Him. They say, "God, I love You" but their works may sometimes lead to disobedience. It's because they have their 'self' in them.

It means when they do a certain work, they use their own thoughts, wisdom, and methods. They insist on what they think is right. In fact, they just do what they want, but they still think they are obeying the word of God. It usually happens when they don't understand and realize the heart of God.

When the results aren't satisfactory or they don't gain recognition or praise, they begin to blame others, not themselves. In fact, this is why they fail to discover their shortcomings. The failure is caused because they mistakenly think that they have faith, fulfill God-given duties well and obey the will of God with an attitude of complacency.



But Jesus did not have any self or ego. He only had Father God in His heart, so He only followed the desires of the Father, without any of His own will. He always prayed and sought the will of Father God during His public ministry. He obeyed in such a way that every single thing was in perfect coherence with the word of God in His ministry (Zechariah 9:9; Matthew 21:2-7). As explained above, Jesus only obeyed the will of God and fulfilled the providence of the salvation of the cross without a single error.

We can also obey the will of God when we deny our 'self' and put it to death just as Apostle Paul did, saying, "I die daily" (1 Corinthians 15:31).



We must have the kind of heart that has no stipulations.

Some people think about stipulations in every matter. They choose what is beneficial for them according to their desires and self-centered motives, and their attitudes can change any time. They obey when it's beneficial for them, but they don't obey giving excuses when it's not beneficial.

But true obedience is not about your benefits. It is not about thinking of the circumstances or the reality nor about giving any excuses. You only take into consideration what the will of God is. You unconditionally obey in any kind of situation as long as it is the will of God.



In Matthew chapter 19, a rich man came before Jesus and asked Him, "Teacher, what good thing shall I do that I may obtain eternal life?" But he was not able to receive the response he wanted to hear from Jesus. Then, the young rich man went away grieving. He came before Jesus with good intentions, but he was only willing to obey up to his own limits. Therefore, he finally followed his own benefit.

Haven't you obeyed for personal fame, authority, or any other self-centered results, or aren't you obeying only what agrees with your way of thinking and what is beneficial for you? You have to obey the will of God in any kind of situation until the end. If you truly want to obey, you can obey with joy until the end.

Jesus did not seek any glory of His own; He only obeyed for the glory of God. That is why He forsook the glorious heavenly throne, came to the earth, and died on the cross being treated like a heinous criminal. By realizing His love and obedience, we should not only obey explicitly what God commands us to do, but also obey with a clear understanding of His heart and will.



We must have the fruit of spiritual love.

When Jesus was hung on the cross, most of His disciples were frightened and ran away, but the women including Mary Magdalene stayed with the Lord until the end. For they loved Him so much they did not feel fear of any danger.

If you love God and the Lord, you can put your 'self' to death and won't think about your circumstances. Without such love, you cannot gain spiritual faith, and you cannot practice the will of God and cannot have hope for heaven either.

Since Jesus loved God so much, He trusted God and hoped for the glorious days during which He would enjoy the heavenly kingdom with God. If you also truly love God, you will believe God and hope for the days that you will have in the heavenly kingdom. Then, you can obey anything. And you can even give your life.



The apostle Paul's confession shows how much he loved God. He said in Romans 8:35-39, "Who will separate us from the love of Christ? Will tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? Just as it is written, 'For Your sake we are being put to death all day long; We were considered as sheep to be slaughtered.' But in all these things we overwhelmingly conquer through Him who loved us. For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, will be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord."

Therefore, remember that true obedience comes out from such deep spiritual love and bear abundant fruit of spiritual love.

“My 3-year-old son came back to life!”

prayer request to Senior Pastor Dr. Jaerock Lee who was praying in his mountain prayer house. Around 7 P.M., I heard that Senior Pastor had just prayed for my son. Then, Yechan spontaneously began breathing independently.

The doctor said that chances were very high that he was in a vegetative state because more than twenty minutes had passed from his cardiac arrest and cessation of breathing until arrival at the hospital. He added that even if he woke up he would not be able to live a normal life.

Though the cardiac arrest went untreated for 20 minutes, his brainwave test showed no damage in his brain.

For a patient whose heart stops in cardiac arrest, life or death can be determined by CPR administered in the 4 minutes directly after onset. This is the so-called ‘golden time.’ If not treated in the time, it usually leads to death, and even if the patient survives, it leads to brain damage. Yechan was treated after more than 20 minutes. However, he received Senior Pastor’s prayer. His brainwave test showed no problem at all, and the doctors said he was really lucky. He recovered quickly day by day. I felt so grateful to God.

He underwent many examinations and was diagnosed with acute myocardial infarction caused by Kawasaki disease complications. Kawasaki disease is a disease in which blood vessels throughout the body become inflamed. The most common symptoms include a fever that lasts for more than five days, and it leads to inflammation in heart blood vessels. It could also form blood clot, which blocks the heart blood vessel and leads to sudden death. His doctor said, “Some parts of his heart coronary arteries are blocked, and some parts are swollen like

balloons. If the vessels burst, he will die.”

His life was not guaranteed due to acute myocardial infarction, but he recovered quickly.

He was too young to have a surgery, so the only possible treatment was medication. From the night of January 3 until the morning of the 4th, he was treated with medication that dissolved the blood clot that had been hardened in his coronary arteries. He stood a chance of death caused by gastric or brain hemorrhage as side effects, but God protected him.

The doctor told us to prepare his last moment that might happen to him the next day. He meant Yechan might die any time. However, he recovered health day by day. On January 6, which was the fourth day after his hospitalization, he didn’t need the respirator and started to drink water.

On Sunday, January 7, he sat up. Senior Pastor prayed again after Sunday Evening Service, and he began to call us, “Mom! Dad! Grandma!”

He even had fun with us. His breath had returned to 100% independent breathing. No problem was detected in his echocardiogram and liver somatic index exam. He moved to the general ward from ICU within a week. He became bright and happy again just as he had been before.

This incident brought great changes to my husband and me. We could no longer be lukewarm in our believing lives and began to attend Daniel Prayer Meeting. My husband, Brother Taesung Oh, stopped drinking alcohol, smoking, and playing games. He now keeps the Lord’s Day completely and attends every meeting to share the grace we received from God. We give all thanks and glory to the living God, and we extend our thanks to Senior Pastor who prayed with love.



Around 2:45 P.M., on January 2, I received a phone call. I heard that my youngest son Yechan (age 3), was in the emergency room at hospital. I was told that he had looked feeble at the daycare center in the morning. He didn’t eat and just slept. In the afternoon, he woke up and suddenly threw up. And while he was being taken to the hospital, he stopped breathing.

After the space-and-time-transcending prayer, he recovered independent breathing.

On the way to the hospital by taxi, I prayed and asked God to save him. When I arrived, he recovered his breathing, but it was not independent. He was 100% relying on the respirator. My family sent a

I lived in pain because I hurt my left leg when I was young. Since 2004 I have suffered from varicose veins. I found it hard to carry heavy baggage and stand for twenty minutes.

My wife and mother-in-law visited many Hindu temples for my healing, but nothing changed. In 2008, my wife even practiced sorcery for my healing although she was pregnant with my second son. Then, she began to do something strange. She suddenly collapsed, vomited, and even had affairs with another man. She was possessed by demons. In April 2010, my family moved to another place.

One day, my first son was healed of his dermatitis. He said that he had received the prayer of the handkerchief on which Dr. Jaerock Lee, Senior Pastor

of Manmin Central Church had prayed when he went to the church near our home (Acts 19:11-12).

We followed him and began to attend Madurai



Manmin Church. Pastor Persiyal Rajadurai said that Pastor Joseph Han (Chennai Manmin Church) would come to the church and lead the handkerchief healing meeting. She said my wife would be healed through the prayer. When she received Pastor Han’s handkerchief prayer, one of the demons left her. Pastor Han urged us to pray in Daniel Prayer Meeting. From then, my family prayed every night and received Pastor Persiyal Rajadurai’s handkerchief prayer. Then, the other demons left her one by one and she recovered completely. Hallelujah!

In August 2017, I visited Korea and participated in Manmin Summer Retreat. When I received Senior Pastor’s prayer for the sick, I was healed of varicose veins in my left leg that had troubled me for 13 years. My second son was suddenly stricken by total paralysis while sleeping. But he was healed through the handkerchief prayer. My whole family experienced the powerful works and has lived with hope for heaven. I give all thanks and glory to God who has blessed us to live a happy life.



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
